- 2. Time 2:40pm. Discussion and possible approval of the findings from the Executive Session for the purpose of possible discussion of settlement or litigation with Attorneys John Thomas and David Weatherford for the Town of Kiowa in reference to the lawsuit with Rural Water District 11.
Mayor Beaver said I am making this motion on behalf of the Town of Kiowa to approve the settlement agreement with Rural Water District #11, at a rate of \$3.50 per thousand gallons of water, adjusted annually by consumer price index (CPI), with 20 million gallons of water provided to Rural Water District #11 at no cost for the next 24 months, not to exceed 4 million gallons per month, and authorizing the Mayor or future Mayor to sign a contract amendment that has these terms, seconded by Burgett. Batts, Burgett, and Beaver voted yes. Motion carried.**
