CALL MEETING TO ORDER: Mayor Naugle called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

1. Discussion and possible approval to hire Aaron Swann as full time Maintenance Worker. Mayor Naugle made the motion to approve to hire Aaron Swann at \$1800.00 per month, with 60 days for insurance and 180 day probation period, seconded by K.Sexton. 3. Discussion and possible approval to pay for repairs on the dozer in the amount of \$3,087.58. William discussed this price including them to come here to do repairs instead of having to load on trailer and transport. 4. Discussion and possible approval to purchase seat and pad for backhoe in amount of \$455.46. Mayor Naugle made the motion to approve the purchase of seat and pad for backhoe not to exceed \$455.46, seconded by Hall. K.Sexton-yes, Hall-yes, VanBlaricom-yes, Peterson-yes, Naugle-yes. Motion carried.
